CURRENT PLANNED WORKS

Works on trial holes around the village commenced on Monday 9th of October and will be completed by early next week (W/c 23/10/23). Some of the trial pits were dug at new streetlighting positions & we have sleeved these to allow for minimal disruption when these are installed. Works will start in the middle of next week along Ferry Street - starting on the lefthand side of the street from the 'Rock'

Porphyry Paving

Porphyry Paving will be installed throughout the scheme. This is a dense natural stone which has stain and mark resistance and is the same as the stone used in the Redburn Square Scheme in Holywood. The image below is of this paving in Redburn Square.


