This will be an opportunity for residents and businesses to be updated on progress to date by the contractor, Northstone Ltd, and to receive information on the next phases of the scheme. Council officers will also be in attendance to offer advice.

Christmas Closure Period (22/12/2023 – 08/01/2024)

Works will be closing on Friday 22nd December 2023 for the Christmas break and will be starting up again on Monday 8th January 2024.

CURRENT PLANNED WORKS

With the final run into Christmas, Northstone Ltd are planning to have all barriers removed and all footways open for the festive break.

Available kerbing has now been complete on Castle Street, and Northstone Ltd plan to have these areas based and open for the Christmas break.

Northstone Ltd have been completing a number of road crossings last week and have encountered quite a lot of rock which needed to be broke out before they could install ducting for the new street lighting.

In the New Year works will begin in the Square and Northstone Ltd will begin excavation and rekerbing from No. 21 below the mobility shop heading towards the Action Cancer Charity Shop. Localised letter drops will be carried out before the Christmas break.

It is also likely that Openreach will also be carrying out some additional works in the early New Year in the footway in front of The Spar towards The Country Garden Fruit and Veg shop.



Scope of scheme

Market Square / Castle Street / Ferry Street / High Street / Meeting House Street.
